Questions for the Week of October 9

1. Ideas about the end of the world have circulated for millennia. What emotions does the topic stir in your mind? Why do you think it fascinates so many people?
2. During our series, we've moved away from speculation toward what the text of Revelation actually teaches. How has your perspective on the Book of Revelation changed, stretched, or deepened during our series?
3. In Revelation 19, the battle of Armageddon turns out not to be much of a battle, as the Rider on the White Horse (=Jesus) quickly defeats all enemies. How does Jesus' power and justice impact your worldview and your daily life?
4. Pastor Quintin shared six takeaways from Revelation 19. Which one(s) stand out to you and why?
 - Warns all against ANTAGONISM, COMPLACENCY, TEMPTATION, and DECEPTION.
 - Encourages followers of Jesus when we're DISCOURAGED, WORRIED, or WEARY.
 - Calls us to PRAY wisely.
 - Allows us to LOVE DEEPLY and FORGIVE those who've WRONGED us.
 - Motivates us to do GOOD WORKS and share the GOOD NEWS.
 - Moves us to SERVE for the ADVANCE of his kingdom.
5. Think about the One Life that God has placed in your path who has not yet trusted in Jesus. Can you share your thoughts and experiences with the group and any prayer requests you have in light of The Return of the King. How can you develop friendships, discover stories, and discern next steps with people who are not yet believers?
