### **After large-group teaching**

8. What should you do if you are with someone who disagrees with your spiritual views, especially your view about Jesus being the way salvation?

(Hint: Scripture calls us to live such good lives among non-believers that they are led to glorify God [1 Peter 2:12]. But ultimately, we cannot convince people. They need God to intervene and be convicted by the Holy Spirit in order to be saved.)
