We will also gather together in the CAFE to show an eighth grade highlight video recapping photos of 8th graders from the last three years. We'll have some time for current 6th and 7th graders to share words of encouragement with the 8th graders.

And then at the end of the night, you will be able to have some social time with your small group, since this is our last time together this school year, I just wanted you to have a final time with your students and there's going to be a popcorn bar and we're going to serve Shirley Temple drinks, which is Sprite with cherry flavoring. So That will be our night.
