I want you to be able to walk away from a Wednesday night knowing whether or not you've had a successful night. Here are three things that I think you should ask yourself at the end of a Wednesday night to gauge how successful you've been.

You know that you've succeeded as a middle school volunteer. If number one, you are able to greet the students in your small group by name with a smile, and students are excited to see you. #2 you connect with at least one student in a meaningful way during the night, whether it's through conversation, prayer, Activities, silliness, whatever that might look like, and #3 you show or tell at least one Student one way that they can deeply love Christ and their neighbors. Basically you're able to have at least one piece of conversation with a student to help them grow in their faith.

And if you can do 1-2 or all three of those things, you know that you have succeeded as a middle school Wednesday night volunteer.
