Is there anything you need to stop doing or start doing so that you do not continue to quench the Holy Spirit? I can't answer those questions for you. You can spend some time between yourself and God to sort those things out. But may you be filled with the spirit? And may you not quench the spirit so that He might flow through you more freely and powerfully, which will impact your everyday life.

It will impact your relationship with Jesus and it'll impact your impact on middle school students as you serve. Thanks for all that you do praise God for His grace. When we fall short, we love you. May we continue to encourage one another and our middle school students as we seek to become more and more like Jesus and follow Him more and more every day!
