

SMALL GROUP NOVEMBER 13

*This week, we're again experimenting with an extended small group time.
This will combine small group social and spiritual time.*

A. Small Group Social (5-7 minutes)

1. Share a high and a low from your week.
2. Do you have a favorite YouTube video or favorite YouTube channel?
3. If you could have your own YouTube channel, what would it be about?
4. What is the ideal length of a YouTube video?
5. What's the maximum amount of time a middle schooler should spend watching YouTube per day?
6. What are the dangers or risk of watching YouTube videos?

B. Small Group Spiritual (20 minutes)

1. What's one thing from the talk that stood out to you?
2. What does it mean to obey?
3. What makes it hard to obey?
4. Why is it important to grow your faith when no one is watching?
5. What is challenging about growing your faith when no one is watching?

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B. Small Group Spiritual (20 minutes) **(Continued)**

6. What are some things you can do to grow your faith when you're not at church?
7. What can you do to surrender to God's power? What does that look like in the life of a middle schooler?
8. What are some things middle schoolers can do to be unified and protect friendships with one another?
9. What do you think it looks like for a middle school follower of Jesus to "shine like stars in the world"? Give some examples.
10. What are some things you can do to learn God's Word?
11. Once you are saved and are following Jesus, what does God want you to do? *(Review the notesheet)*
12. Out of the six things we talked about that God wants you to do once you're saved, what one thing do you want to focus on over the next week?

C. Small Group Prayer (5-7 minutes)

Invite kids from your group to share prayer requests. Then invite others from your group to pray for those requests out loud as you wrap up your time!
