



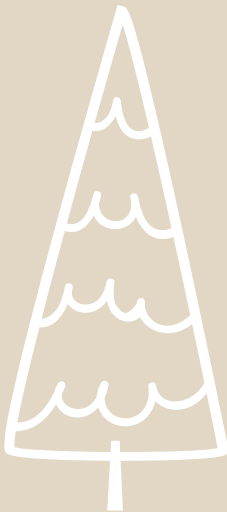

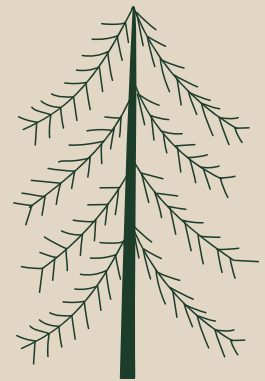
SOCIAL QUESTIONS
