And these are questions that you can ask of yourself to help you gauge how you're doing in your own relationship as a follower of Jesus.

It's also a question that you can ask to help you gauge where the students in your small group are at.

So my specific challenge for you this week is to pick one student in your small group and pick one of the impact questions.

And as you're interacting with that student this Wednesday night, have that impact question in mind and try to answer for that student where you think they are at in regards to that specific question.

Or you could even outright ask that student that question.

You know, you could say something like, "Hey, I'm trying to go around asking students to kind of think about where they're at in your faith. And one way to think about it is, you know, by asking how's my relationship with Christ deepening on a daily basis," or whatever the question is.

And you could just ask it to that student and then listen.

And, you know, there's no judgment. There's no right or wrong answer. just a way for us to get a gauge of where kids are at.

So pick one student and one question and as you interact with that student have that question in mind this Wednesday night. It's a good way for you to know where the kids in your small group are at which helps you be more effective and more strategic in how you're approaching and pouring into students.
