Hey middle school volunteers, these are the announcements for February 26, 2025.

The theme for this coming Wednesday is fitness night, so you want to wear some comfortable shoes. We're going to do some fun physical fitness. We're not going to be super intense. We're not going to try to break kids and make them cry, but we'll have some fun moving around and working up a little bit of a sweat.

This is also going to be week three of our heart to heart series. We're going to talk about God's design for sex, which is a biblical view, a traditional biblical view. The only sexual relationship that the Bible affirms is between one man and one woman in the context of a loving marriage. Anything outside of that is outside of God's design.

Our next special event is on Saturday, March 8. It is called Super Saturday. It's a progressive fast food dinner that goes from 6 o'clock to 9 o'clock p.m. You are invited to join us.
