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LIFE GROUP GUIDE

SHARE

- 1. Describe one of your favorite peaceful settings.
- 2. Which teacher is the most memorable to you? Share a classroom lesson that you still remember today.

STUDY

- 3. Read John 16:25. What is Jesus referring to when he says he's been speaking in figures of speech? What topics has he been talking about in veiled language?
- 4. When reading scripture, we can often identify with the well-intentioned but regularly confused disciples. Share a time when you were reading scripture and a passage finally made sense to you. (John 16:25, 29-32)
- 5. Read John 16:27-28. God's love for you is inextricably linked to the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus. You can't earn more love and you can't lose love. How does this cause you to respond when you think about loving your neighbor, family, coworker, etc.?
- 6. Read John 16:33. What is our source of peace? It is easy to find our peace in worldly security (money, people, property, etc.) instead of from Jesus. What can you do this week to increase the peace that Jesus makes available to his followers?
- 7. If Jesus has overcome the world, how does that affect how you approach your bold moves of faith?

DIGGING DEEPER

- 8. Read Mark 9:17-29. What does this account say about the role of our faith and Jesus's role as overcomer?
- 9. In what situations do you find yourself needing to cry out to God to help your unbelief, even in the midst of your belief (v. 23-24)? How are you strengthened as a result of this admission of unbelief?
- 10. What is the relationship between praying and faith (v. 24, 28-29)? What is the relationship between prayer and carrying out the work Jesus has given you?

SUPPORT

11. Prayer is powerful! Spend some time praying for your One Life—for your friendship, for any needs in their life, for their faith and salvation.
